INTRODUCTION

Kouga Local Municipality intends to appoint a service provider for the subdivision, rezoning of Portion 38 of Farm Loerie River 436.

BACKGROUND

Kouga Municipality is currently in the process of planning an Integrated Residential Development Program that will provide for the needs of the community of Loerie. Due to the demand in developable land for integrated human settlements in this area, Council has taken a decision to subdivide the Erf and rezone it to the appropriated land uses.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to set out the terms of reference on which professional teams should base their tender for delivering a professional service for Kouga Local Municipality. The tender should clearly state the approach to be adopted, the proposed methodology, relevant experience, time frame, program and associated budget and the proposed team members.
